Children & Youth Partnership for Dare County Training Descriptions

ITS-SIDS

Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within two months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare homes providers licensed to care for infants.

Emergency Preparedness and Response in Child Care Training

Emergency preparedness and response (EPR) rules went into effect July 1, 2015. The rules are designed to assist licensed child care programs to be adequately prepared to respond to the needs of children and others in the event of disasters and emergencies. Participants will learn more about the rules and the required emergency preparedness and response plan.

Playground Safety

Playground Safety Training addresses playground safety hazards, supervision, and general upkeep of the outdoor area. It is required for all licensed child care centers, but has very helpful and important information for family child care home providers as well.

Supporting and Promoting Children's Emotional and Social Development

Often overlooked by teachers in curriculum planning, supporting children's emotional and social development is foundational to all other development in early childhood. In this session we'll define the domain of emotional and social development in young children and explain the associated subdomains listed in NC Foundations for Early Learning and Development. We'll identify evidence-based strategies for creating positive relationships and designing supportive environments in preschool classrooms, and explore activities and teacher practices which support that development. Find out how you can tweak your practices to intentionally promote this foundational development in your preschool classroom! (2 DCDEE contact hours)

Language Development and Communication in Infants and Toddlers: What Are They Talking About?

It starts with crying, cooing, and babbling, and then you finally hear it, their first words! Sharing those language milestone moments can be some of our best experiences as infant and toddler teachers. During this workshop you will learn more about the development of language and communication for children birth to three; the research that links relationships to language learning in the first three years; and strategies to support development in this domain for all infants and toddlers, including dual language learners. In addition, participants will have a chance to discuss and share their ideas about the importance of talking to, singing with, and reading to infants and toddlers to foster a life time love of language and learning. This training provides information that supports the ITERS-R subscales: Personal Care Routines, Listening and Talking and Interactions. (DCDEE 8)

Solutions to the Dilemma: Reducing Suspension & Expulsion in ECE Programs.

Suspension and expulsion from child care can have long-lasting negative effects on both children and families. It is the intent of the NC DCDEE to severely limit the use of these exclusionary practices in programs serving children birth—five. This informational meeting will acquaint facility administrators and owners with NC's new Suspension/Expulsion Policy and explore the importance of promoting healthy social-emotional development in preventing the challenging behaviors which often lead to suspension/expulsion. Also included are effective program policies and procedures which support the shift from exclusion to retention of young children. This is a FREE informational session designed especially for Child Care Owners, Administrators and Family Child Care Home Operators.
