Children & Youth Partnership for Dare County- Training Descriptions

ITS-SIDS - Infant/Toddler Safe Sleep & SIDS Risk Reduction in Child Care training. Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within two months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare homes providers licensed to care for infants.

Creating Classroom Environments that Reduce Challenging Behaviors

This training is from Pyramid Preschool Model. It focuses on practices for establishing high-quality supportive classroom environments that promote social-emotional skill development and prevent challenging behavior. Participants will receive materials they can implement that support classroom schedules, routines, transitions, and promoting expectations and rules.

Guiding the Behavior of Toddlers and Twos in Group Care

This workshop is from the Program for Infant and Toddler Care (PITC). We will explore how the developmental characteristics of infants and toddlers influence behaviors we find challenging. We will review useful prevention, guidance, and discipline techniques caregivers can implement to support social emotional skills.

Supporting Developmental Monitoring and Screening in Early Care and Education Settings

We know that monitoring and screening in early childhood early care and education settings is critical to identifying children at risk for developmental delays. What is less known is how programs use developmental monitoring and screening tools and ways caregivers talk with families about their children's growth and development. This training will help participants understand the differences in developmental monitoring and screening and why they are so important to children and families. Participants will learn how they can track and celebrate children's milestones and strategies for collaborating with families on supporting children's healthy growth. You can play an essential role in our state's early intervention efforts!

Promoting Emotional Literacy and Friendship Skills in Preschoolers

This training is from Pyramid Preschool Model. Promoting social-emotional development is core to the Pyramid Model. This module provides training on the practices for teaching friendship skills, emotional literacy, self-regulation, and problem-solving. Participants will receive materials they can in their classroom.

Temperament: A Practical Approach to Meeting Individual Needs

Temperament refers to a combination of tendencies that make up an individual's natural way of relating to people, things, and events. This session reviews updated research findings on temperament, the five temperament tendencies, the impact of culture, and the concept of Goodness-of-fit. We will review strategies for responding to individual differences in temperament in children in group care.

Emergency Preparedness and Response in Child Care Training

Emergency preparedness and response (EPR) rules went into effect July 1, 2015. The rules and training are designed to assist licensed child care programs to be adequately prepared to respond to the needs of children and others in the event of disasters and emergencies. Participants will learn about the rules and the

required emergency preparedness and response plan. **Additional EPR training may be scheduled in Dare County as needed, upon request. Please contact Jennifer Bradshaw Garrett to schedule, jbradshaw@darekids.org , 252-441-0614, line 8.**
